

Meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m. by Wright with The Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion/Mettler: Second/Wright to approve the September 2021 minutes. Carried 2-0.

Motion/Wright: Second/Mettler to approve the Treasurer's Report. Carried 2-0.


