## Town of Embarrass

Regular Board Meeting

December 13, 2017

### Pending Board Approval

Present: Zane Beaton, Bernie Mettler, Roy Worsham, Mary Novak, Jennifer Boese

Visitors: Paul Knuti, Cassandra Hainey, Gene Wright

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Zane with The Pledge of Allegiance.

*Motion by Roy to approve the November 8 minutes. Second by Bernie.*

*Motion by Roy to approve the November 28 Post Office Minutes. Second by Bernie.*

*Motion by Zane to approve the Treasurer's Report. Second by Roy. Carried 3-0.*

Maintenance Report was given by Roy. Shoveling and plowing of snow. Kitchen sink and hot water heater repaired at the Town Hall. Removed down trees. Helped with burials. Pump house repairs. Placing flags at the cemetery as orders come in for ice candles. Busy making ice candles and preparing for Ice Candle Celebration. Continuous maintenance duties. *Motion by Roy for maintenance to purchase a drag for use at township properties. Second by Bernie. Carried 3-0.* Board agrees with maintenance suggestion to purchase reflectors to put on trails. Purchase of new chain saw was discussed. Roy will look into the chainsaws for maintenance.

Cassandra Hainey spoke with the board about the grant application. The CDBG was preapproved. She asks the board for someone to attend a presentation with her in January. One board member will attend. Paul asks about a booklet that should be on file about past grant work. (Clerk notes: Mary Novak has brought book in, clerk made copies.) Cassandra tells the board about a group that

may possibly do the labor at a reduced rate. *Motion by Bernie to have Paul explore and act on writing up something for the signs at the Pyhala Homestead. Second by Zane. Carried 3-0.* Paul explains that the foundation should be fixed and would cost \$100,000 - \$150,000 and that looking into grants from the MN Historical Society would be a good idea. Roy explains that we have the Post Office Project going on, siding on Nelmark to be done, and will be having to look into purchasing a plow truck with the St. Louis County contracts changing. Discussion was held on purchasing a plow truck, will be discussed again at a later time for decision.

Board has chosen January 3 at 6:00 p.m. for employee potluck at the Town Hall.

Post Office Update was given by Bernie. Electric and heating is done. The mudders and tapers are working currently on the project. Snow bar has been placed on the roof. More had to be ordered. Cedar siding on the front of the building has been done. Bernie was told by the construction workers that they are impressed with the community and have been very helpful. Landscaping will have to be done in the summer, to save money for the township it would be a good idea to have maintenance do the work. Summer hire can also help with the landscaping.

*Motion by Zane to approve correspondence and claims 16661-16692 (\$48,196.31), Payroll (\$6,141.71), Second by Bernie. Carried 3-0.*

Meeting adjourned at 6:55 p.m.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Board Chair Mitch Lind and the Pledge of Allegiance followed.

**Minutes Approval:** Mitch moved to approve the October 3, 2017 Regular Meeting Minutes. Phil supported. Carried (2-0).

**Treasurer's Report from October Meeting:** Receipts: \$19.95 from State of MN (MV Credit--Agriculture) and \$343.66 (Stop payment on check #4004—Lakes Gas Co.). Total Disbursements: \$1,897.17. Phil accepted the report and Mitch supported. Carried (2-0).

**Road Report:** Phil reported that side roads are snow covered and icy in places. Beckman Road is in good condition after the new gravel and grading that was done recently. That area will be monitored again in the spring.

**Correspondence:** A letter was received from St. Louis County concerning tax forfeit land in Waasa. No action will be taken by the board. All other mail was read and filed. was received from St. Louis County concerning tax forfeit

**Adjournment:** Phil moved to close the meeting at 8:05 p.m. and was supported by Mitch.


